

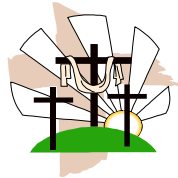

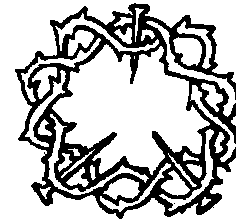
### EASTER PREPARATIONS
