ST JAMES DAY AND CONFIRMATION SERVICE (25 JULY)

St James Day (25 July) is the anniversary of our church. This 'birthday' each year is a good opportunity to pause and thank God for his goodness to our church. Sunday 25 July, 2010 marks the 111th anniversary of St James, Turrumurra. Bishop Glenn Davies will be preaching at our services at St James.

Bishop Davies will also be conducting our confirmation service at 7pm that evening. We will be meeting in the main church building (not the hall) and there will be a celebratory supper to follow in the memorial hall. All members of the congregation are warmly encouraged to attend in support of our confirmees.



ST JAMES DAY APPEAL To celebrate the 111th Anniversary of St James Turrumurra we are embarking on plans to upgrade the War Memorial Hall, and we will be encouraging all parishioners to share in the project with donations of \$111 (or multiples thereof). We are also finalising an application for a Government Grant to match the donations. To meet our growing needs for Kids Club, Sunday Night Church, Bible Study Fellowship and other weekday activities, the project will include replacing the stage with more meeting space (and a portable stage when needed), installing foldback partitioning to allow for smaller class areas, disability access and toilet facilities, together with storage and office space. ST JAMES MT DRUITT OP SHOP—DELIVERY Monday, 2 August

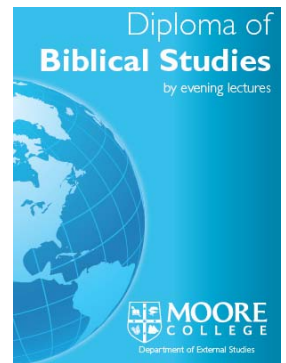
