### JOIN A HOME BIBLE STUDY GROUP FOR 2010

One of the best ways to grow in our relationship with God and to deepen our relationship with other Christians is by joining a Home Bible Study Group. ### REMINDER ABOUT PARKING ARRANGEMENTS AT ST JAMES

St James has adopted a system of regulated parking to help ensure that our less mobile parishioners are able to park close to the church. To do this, the wardens request that the congregation follows these guidelines.

- Only holders of blue, yellow or green parking permits should park in the spaces so designated.
- King Street and the front of the church grounds are best used by the 7.45am and 10.15am parishioners. St James Lane, Cherry Street, Eastern road (north of St James Lane) and the rear of the church grounds are best used by the 9.00am parishioners. The 9.00am congregation should not park in King Street or Eastern Rd (south of St James Lane).

2009 Parking permits will expire on 31 Jan 2010. Existing permit holders and those requiring a permit will need to apply for a new permit. The forms are available from the rear of the church.
