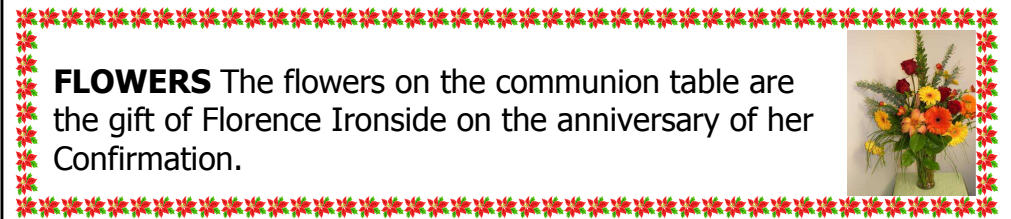
**ST JAMES DAY APPEAL** To celebrate the 111th Anniversary of St James Turramurra we are embarking on plans to upgrade the War Memorial Hall, and we will be encouraging all parishioners to share in the project with donations of \$111 (or multiples thereof). We are also finalising an application for a Government Grant to match the donations. To meet our growing needs for Kids Club, Sunday Night Church, Bible Study Fellowship and other weekday activities, the project will include replacing the stage with more meeting space (and a portable stage when needed), installing foldback partitioning to allow for smaller class areas, disability access and toilet facilities, together with storage and office space.
