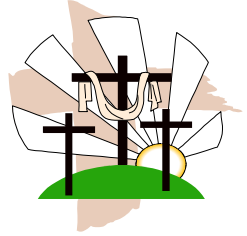

CHRISTIANITY EXPLAINED : 4 MONDAYS FROM 19 APRIL

Christianity Explained is a four-week introductory course for people wanting to look at the basics of the Christian faith, based on a guided tour of Mark's gospel. It is suitable for those who are curious about the Christian faith, those who are not quite sure what to believe, and those who are Christians but would like a refresher in the basics. You can ask all the questions you like, but you won't be put on the spot to answer questions or to read the Bible or pray aloud. This course will be led by our rector, Michael Stead over four Mondays (19 and 26 April, 3 and 10 May) from 7.30pm to 8.30pm, meeting in the Rector's office. CONFIRMATION CLASSES: SUNDAYS IN TERM 2: 5.30-6.30PM

Confirmation provides an opportunity for a person to make a public declaration of their faith in Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord. For those baptised as children, it is an opportunity to confirm the promises made on their behalf in baptism. Candidates are prepared for Confirmation through teaching them what it means to be a Christian, and how to live as one to enable them to take responsibility for their own adult Christian lives.

This course will be led by Rev. Dr Michael Stead, Rev. Sturt Young and Mr Ed Hungerford. Confirmation classes will be held from 5.30pm to 6.30pm on Sunday evenings, commencing 2 May and running for nine weeks. A separate adult Confirmation class will be run if there is sufficient interest.

The Confirmation service will be at 7.00pm on Sunday 25 July. The minimum age for confirmation candidates is 16 years (or Year 10 in High School). If you are interested in joining this course, please contact the church office, or pick up a copy of the application form which is available in the church porches.
