



## A BEQUEST

You are able to make St James Turrumurra a beneficiary in your will, knowing that your generosity will allow your gift to be used for gospel ministry after your death.

You should talk to your solicitor about making a bequest to St James Turrumurra.

Here is a suggested wording to use when leaving a bequest to St James.

I give the Rector and Churchwardens for the time being of St James Anglican Church Turrumurra \$..... to be used and applied as they may in their discretion determine for or towards ministry both within and outside the Parish.

I declare that a receipt from the Rector or any one of the Churchwardens for the time being of the said church will be a full and sufficient discharge to my executor for such legacy and my executor will not be bound or concerned to see the application thereof.

For your will to be valid some points you need to know:

it must be either handwritten, printed or typed

it must be dated

it must be personally signed by the person making the will

the signature must be witnessed by two independent witnesses who cannot be the executor/s, beneficiaries or spouse of either executor/s or beneficiaries.
